

Chilled water will be carried through nearly four miles of underground piping (heavy lines) to provide "community air conditioning" for Lake Anne Village at Reston, Va., the first complete town to be air conditioned from a central plant (circle). Three Carrier water chilling machines will supply a total of 1,200 tons of cooling capacity to the townhouses, apartments and shops. Heating in each townhouse will be supplied by a gas-fired furnace. The Reston master plan calls for six more village centers by 1980, creating a self-sustaining city of 75,000 out of rolling hills and woodland 18 miles from Washington, D.C.
