1. Batesville, Mississippi -- December 21-31, 1969.  
Provided medical and dental screening for 1,060  
five year old head start children and 200 adults.
2. Marks, Mississippi -- December, 1969.  
Distributed clothing, food, toys to low-income  
families.
3. Freedmen's Hospital, Washington, D. C. -- February, 1970  
to April, 1970.  
Sponsored hospitalization for surgery and other  
treatment for adults and children from the North  
Delta area.
4. College of Dentistry, Washington, D. C. -- August, 1970.  
Provided dental treatment for 300 five year old  
children from five counties in Mississippi.
5. Department of Home Economics, Howard University,  
Washington, D. C. -- August, 1970  
Provided much needed educational experience for  
300 children from Mississippi.
6. Batesville, Mississippi -- December, 1970  
Provided medical and dental screening for 960  
head start children.
7. Marks, Mississippi -- December, 1970  
Distributed clothing, food, toys to low-income  
families.
8. Quitman County, Mississippi -- December, 1970  
Delivery of mobile health unit which is to be  
used as temporary health facility.
9. Equipment purchased includes: blood analyzer, two portable  
dental units, centrifuges, refrigerator and medical and  
dental supplies, however, much more equipment is still  
needed to facilitate our dental and medical operations.
