SUBJECT: Report of the Task Force on New Towns

In accord with your memorandum of August 21, 1967, transmitted herewith is the Report of the Task Force on New Towns.

The Report recommends a new Federal program of aids for the development of new communities. These aids, at minimal Federal costs, would help remove the present impedimints to the private development of new communities; they would also encourage and support the states and their subdivisions to participate fully in public-private ventures towards the same end.

The Task Force believes that its recommendation, when implemented, will make a significant contribution to the Nation's ability to develop sound metropolitan regions, viable cities, and more attractive rural communities.
