In response to repeated requests by you, the following is a brief summary of 1972 Festival Activities Chronological report of 1972 Festival Activities ~~from the~~ at the administrative level.

As you are aware Festival Proceedings commenced in November of 1971. It was the intention of the Chairperson at that time to proceed in the direction of a ~~more~~ larger seated than that of prior years. As a result of several meetings, projections and possible avenues were explored. ~~At~~ At this point, real possibilities were recognized and Committees and set up to support these projections.

Many meetings took place before any real achievements began to ~~visualize~~ materialize. These meetings accomplished such goals as Festival's theme, Charity, kinds of exhibits,

speakers, entertainment, messages and continuity.

It was also disclosed that the job of the Chairperson took more man hours to do
