RESTON BLACK FOCUS
Membership Campaign

At our last general meeting, RESTON BLACK FOCUS adopted a proposal which calls for minimal formal structure and definitive membership to be established by November 1, 1969. The experiences of our successful Black Arts Festival and the scope of anticipated projects indicated the necessity for this action. A summary of the important details of this proposal follows:

- Membership in RESTON BLACK FOCUS will be open to any black family (i.e. at least one black person in the family). Residence in Reston is not required.
- Membership fees will be minimal and will be waived for the first year.
- On November 1, 1969 a charter committee will present an organizational charter to the members for approval.
- The formal organization will revolve around a steering committee of four regular elected members and all active committee chairmen.
- The elections will be held on November 1, 1969 immediately following adoption of the charter.

The charter committee's guidelines include setting up a structure which will allow maximum opportunity for individual creativity and productivity, keeping in mind the aim of RESTON BLACK FOCUS to serve as a framework for black cultural, educational, civic and social activities in Reston and the surrounding area.

A member of the membership committee will call on you in the next few days to register your membership and encourage your participation in RESTON BLACK FOCUS. Remember, it is important to register your membership before the
